

# Salt Lake City School District Board Policy P - 8

It is the policy of the Salt Lake City School District Board of Education to permit employees Internet access under regulations listed in the administrative procedures. The Internet is an electronic highway connecting computers and individual subscribers world-wide. The information found on the Internet ranges from material with high educational value to inappropriate material with little educational value. Salt Lake City School District has taken available precautions to restrict access to inappropriate materials. An Acceptable Use Contract must be signed by all employees. However, on a global network it is impossible to control all materials for all users at all times. In general, the district requires responsible, decent, ethical, polite, efficient, and legal use of its network resources.

The purpose of this policy is to inform all employees of the guidelines that must be followed to gain Internet access.
