



"Official Utah Middle and High School Immunization Rules 2008-2009"

3 Hepatitis B

- Grades 7-9
- Highly recommended for all ages.

1 Tetanus/Diphtheria (Td) Booster Within Last 5 Years

- Grades 7-9
- The Pertussis (Whooping Cough) vaccine is not required for adolescents. However, new adolescent Td/Pertussis (Tdap) vaccines can be given to satisfy the Td requirement and is highly recommended.

1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)

- Grades 7-9
- Proof of previous history of disease is acceptable.
- If the first dose is given after 13 years old, two doses are required.
- 2 Chicken Pox Shots are highly, highly recommended for every child.

2 MMR

3-4 Polio

2 Hepatitis A

- Highly recommended, but not required.

1 Meningitis

- Highly recommended, but not required.

3 Gardasil (HPV)

- Girls only, age 11 and above. Will be offered to the boys in the near future.
- Given for prevention of HPV and Cervical Cancer.
- Given at this early age because the immune system will have the absolute best response to the vaccine. The vaccine works best if given before exposure. Exposure need only be skin to skin contact.
- Jon Huntsman has donated \$1,000,000 to the Utah Department of Health to increase awareness of this vaccine and to provide low-cost doses.
- Highly recommended, but not required.
