PART 1 – HEARING AND VISION SCREENING

Grades: K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6

The State of Utah mandates periodic hearing and vision screening. The district performs school-wide hearing screening each school year for Kindergarten, second grade, fifth grade and special education students as well as for students that have been referred by teachers and parents. The Salt Lake City School District routinely vision screens children in Kindergarten, first, third, and sixth grades, resource and special education students and other students upon teacher or parent request in other grades. A parent/guardian may request in writing that her/his child be exempt from screening according to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

PART 2 – UTAH STATEWIDE IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION SYSTEM (USIIS)

Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6

Immunization information will be entered into the Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS). A parent/guardian may request in writing that her/his child be exempt from entry into the state registry according to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

PART 3 – HIV/AIDS EDUCATION

Grades 3, 4, 5, and 6

HIV/AIDS education is a required part of the Utah State Office of Education Health Core Curriculum. The presentation will be given by state trained personnel. The presentation has been given approval by the Salt Lake City School District. The curriculum is available for parent preview on the Salt Lake City School District Health Services web page.
