A Resolution of the Board of Education of the Salt Lake City School District regarding a Weapon, Violence, and Drug Free Environment.

WHEREAS, state and federal law supports any and all efforts to prevent violence and drug use in and around schools; and

WHEREAS, private residences and houses of worship can prohibit weapons by giving proper notice; and

WHEREAS, the public has consistently asserted the expectation that our schools need to be safe, weapon free, and drug free; and


WHEREAS, it has been demonstrated that young people attending our public schools perform better when they are in a safe learning environment; and

WHEREAS, the Salt Lake City School District Board of Education has worked diligently to prevent violence and drug use while striving to understand and then explain to students, parents, and staff the lack of protection from weapons afforded to private residences and houses of worship;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Salt Lake City School District requests the Utah Legislature to support its children, families, and school by providing at least the same protection from weapons that is afforded private residences and houses of worship.


