## SLVSEF 2010 Participation Summary

### Salt Lake School District

Thank you for participating in the 2010 SLVSEF. This year's fair was our biggest yet and we appreciate all the hard work you and your staff put in to help students design, carry out and present great science fair projects. We recognize that you often don't receive any information back on how your students did at the regional fair. We have therefore created this simple report to provide some summary statistics to you.

At this year's fair, a total of 185 students competing in 122 unique projects advanced from Salt Lake School District. The break-down by division is shown below. Elementary projects consisted of 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> graders. Junior division was 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders while Senior division was 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders.

There were 338 total awards distributed during the awards ceremony that included 195 certificates, plaques, trophies, etc. and cash prizes totaling \$348,525. Salt Lake School District received 141 of these awards, including 87 certificates, etc. and \$251,640 won by 76 unique projects. These projects came from the following divisions:
