

After-school **Ensemble Music** Program for Salt Lake School District



Chapman Music Institute (CMI) is an accredited community music program offered through the GAM Foundation of Utah (a 501c3 non-profit entity) that has partnered with SLSD to provide supplemental music classes for students participating in Salt Lake Schools music programs. This program is a parent paid afterschool program, but provides for scholarships to qualified students in our Title I schools.



CMI is a perfect option for:

- Students who would like additional opportunities to play in an ensemble after school including Orchestra, Guitar Ensemble, (Concert Band and Jazz Band starting in 2012)
- Students who would benefit in receiving instruction on their instrument through professionally taught master classes
- Students who want to improve their performance in their school music program

GAM and CMI require that a student participating in one of its groups, must also participate in the same type of ensemble if offered by their school.

The price of the program is \$60 per month plus a registration fee and runs for the school year.



The program includes:

- Weekly Ensemble Rehearsals
- One Rehearsal Session will include sectional master classes taught by a certified teacher on each instrument
- A license for the Smart Music interactive music practice software application and a 1 year subscription to the Smart Music library of music literature

Classes will be held at West High School beginning in October 2011

The CMI program is very economically priced for a full ensemble instruction program and utilizes a hybrid distance learning model and is based on the award winning Chapman Music All-star Ensemble program <http://calebchapmanmusic.com>.
