THE POLICY

The Salt Lake City School District Board of Education will review and consider every district sponsored charter school application that complies with state law. If a district sponsored charter school application is approved, the terms and conditions for the operation of the charter school will be clearly set forth in a written charter agreement. All charter schools sponsored by the board are required to comply with all federal and state laws, rules and regulations, and district policies and procedures except those policies and procedures for which a waiver is approved in the charter agreement. In accordance with state law the board also has the right to terminate a charter school it has sponsored.

The purpose of this policy is to establish procedures for submitting charter school applications, and seeking board approval for the creation of a district sponsored charter school.

No district employee or student shall be subjected to discrimination in employment or any district program or activity on the basis of age, color, disability, gender, gender identity, genetic information, national origin, pregnancy, race, religion, sexual orientation, or veteran status.
