## Elementary Plan

Approved by SLCSD Board on November 17

1. Continue with a high-quality remote option for students
2. Continue with in-person for small groups
3. Option to select in-person learning
  - January 25 – In-person option for grades PreK – K – 1
  - February 1 – In-person option for grades 2 and 3
  - February 8 – In-person option for grades 4 – 5 – 6

## Moving Forward . . .

- Remote learning will remain the default option for students
- Based on information from elementary registration, about 64% are choosing in-person learning
- We know that masking works and will continue to be required
- Educators are in the first tier for vaccinations
  - Highly effective
- All teachers work from school beginning on January 25th




# Vaccines for School Employees

- Coordinated through Community Nursing Services and SLCSD Student Services Department
  - It is estimated that the first dose of vaccine for teachers may be the last week of January.



## Strategies for Success

- All mitigation strategies that have been previously planned will be in place
  - Masks are required at all times except breakfast and lunch, including buses, hallways, and classrooms
  - Social distancing implemented to the extent possible
  - Enhanced cleaning
  - Plexiglass barriers
  - Community awareness campaign
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# Secondary Proposal

- Secondary Schools
  - Beginning an in-person option is dependent on vaccines for employees
  - Asynchronous Wednesdays will continue
  - All assignments and course information will continue to be in Canvas
  - Middle schools will continue on current schedule



## Moving Forward . . .

- Students who will not mask or social distance will be educated through remote learning
- Every classroom will have a camera to live stream and record
- Students in remote can continue to get meals from school
- Schools are prepared for remote learning as needed

## High School Specific

- Continue on same 4-period schedule as currently in place
- Possible to attend some classes in person and some remote
  - This will help keep in-person numbers at a minimum
- Connections/relationships with remote students will be supported:
  - Teacher assistants
  - Classroom buddies
  - Paraprofessionals





## To Do Now

- Determine who will be remote or in-person in high school
  - Determine which classes will be only remote or only in-person
  - Review students' schedules for Semester 2
- Determine who will be remote or in-person in middle schools
- Implement a public awareness campaign about mitigation
- Continue to expand opportunities for in-person small groups
