

Tribal Enrollment Office Contact Information (How to enroll during COVID-19 Pandemic)

- Navajo Nation - The Navajo Nation requires members to contact one of their agencies, which are closed to in-person visits right now. During the pandemic they are asking for a written, notarized request to the agency the tribal members belong to.
 - Agencies:
 - Western Navajo
 - Northern Navajo
 - Fort Defiance
 - Chinle
 - Eastern Navajo
 - Extra Information:
 - A person **MUST** be at least 1/4 (one quarter) Navajo to be enrolled as a member of the Navajo Nation. To determine if you are eligible for tribal membership, contact the Navajo tribe.
