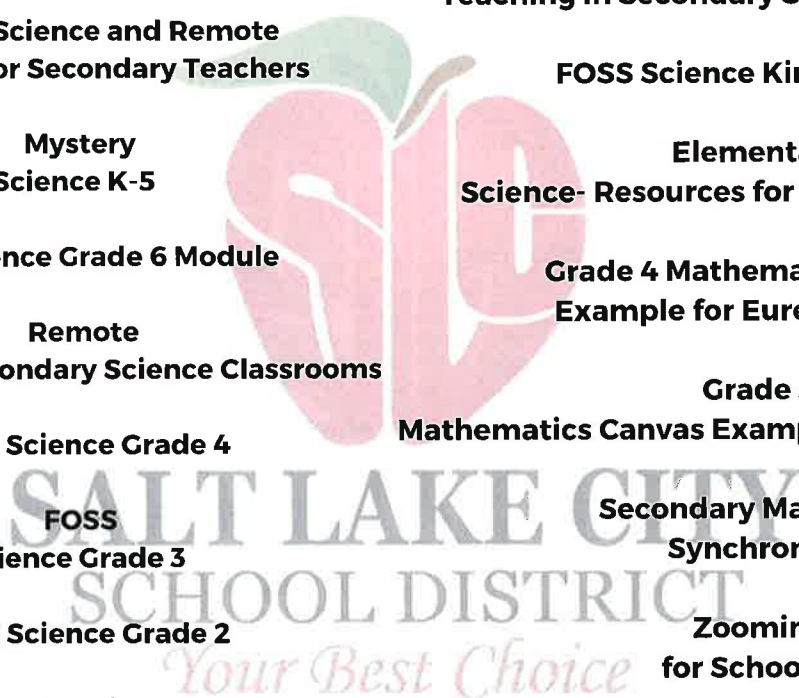

Our preparation to deal with the emotional aftermath of these difficult events can improve support for students, colleagues, and families. Effective crisis response can build resilience and restore a safe and healthy learning environment. The situation presented in the training is suicide postvention; however, the skills are applicable to supporting all types of crisis response. The course will take about 40 minutes.
