

## PARAPROFESSIONAL ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

If you are interested in making a difference in the life of a child, and would like to work alongside classroom teachers to provide targeted instruction as a paraeducator, we can help! Paraeducators are required to have highly qualified status by either having 48 college credit hours, or passing the Paraeducator Praxis exam. If you need to take the Paraeducator Praxis exam, we can help!

How Salt Lake City School District employees can take the exam:

- Mondays through Thursdays from 9:30 to 11:00 am
- Salt Lake Community College campus (1575 South State Street)
- To schedule an appointment, go to <u>https://www2.registerblast.com/</u> <u>saltlakecc/Exam/List</u> and follow the prompts
  - Select the location as Salt Lake City
  - Select the category as Salt Lake City School District only

The ParaPro Assessment takes approximately 2.5 hours. The assessment cost is \$65.00 and is due prior to taking the exam. You can pay online with any major credit or debit card or pay at the testing center with cash or any major credit/debit card.

Please arrive a few minutes early to the testing site and bring a photo I.D.
